

My Map and Best Time

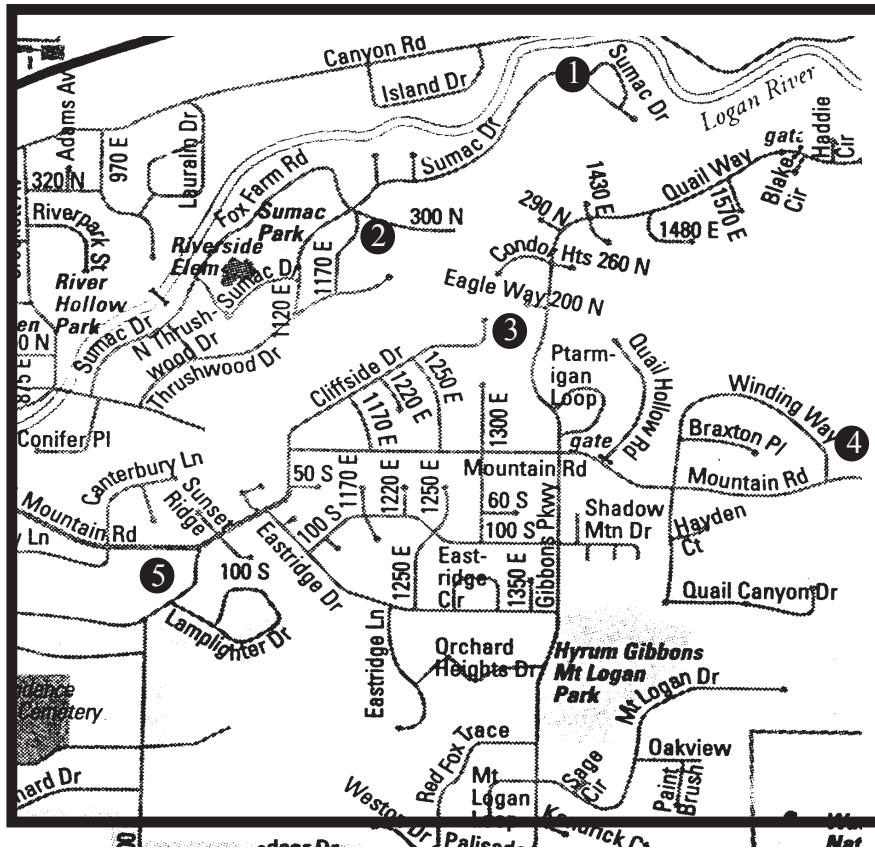
